Statement	Temporary transportation arrangements will not be allowed, except under special circumstances as approved by the General Manager. Situations regarding child safety that impact transportation requirements will be dealt with under the Administrative Policy A-009 Child Protection Situations.
Examples of Refused Requests	 The following list identifies situations that will result in temporary transportation being refused. This list <u>is</u> not an exhaustive list of situations whereby transportation will not be provided: 1. The student wants to go to a friend's house for school work or other reasons. 2. The parent/guardian must work later than expected and wants the student to go to another house. 3. The parent/guardian cannot get to the bus stop on time (if the parent/designate isn't there the child will be brought back to the school if they are in JK/SK). 4. The parent/guardian must be away for a few days or weeks because of an emergency. 5. The parent/guardian will be away on holiday and the student is staying at another home. 6. The parent/guardian is on a business trip and the student is staying at another home. 7. The student is visiting a relative or friend. 8. The student is taking lessons after school once a week. 9. The student has an after school job. 10. The student wants to go to the parent's workplace after school. 11. The student has medical or other appointments.
